

## You can be a Master Gardener if:

- You attend all training classes where you will learn about insects, plant health, vegetables, fruits, turf, ornamentals and more.
- You are willing to provide research based information to the public.
- You can give 40 volunteer hours of service back to the Master Gardener Program.

## Where are classes held?

- LSU partners with UL to conduct the training at ULL's Ira Nelson Horticulture Center, 2206 Johnston St.
- Classes are held on either Tuesdays or Thursdays from 8:45 am–3:00 pm, August through November.

## How much does the training cost?

- The cost of the program is about \$200. This includes the cost of the manual, badge, certificate and an activity fee. In return for the training, Master Gardeners have 1 year to complete 40 volunteer hours to the Master Gardener Program.

## What happens after the initial obligation?

- You may continue as a Lafayette Parish Master Gardener by paying dues of \$20, taking 6 hours of additional horticulture education and performing 20 hours of volunteer service each year. Monthly educational meetings are held the first Wednesday of each month and members continue to meet year round at the LPMGA greenhouse to practice plant propagation and maintain demonstration beds.
